## Our Mission:

Our programs this summer include 11-14 days of summer camps, 2-4 community events, and providing hospitality to 12 or more churches and organizations running overnight camps.

## **Position Summary**

We are looking for a Summer Camp Intern(s) to lead summer camps, assist with camp administration, and manage hospitality to the churches and groups that rent the camp. The ideal candidate is a hard worker with experience at summer camp, desires to learn the inner workings of running a camp business and can lead Christian discipleship discussions with youth.

## **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- 1. The Summer Camp Intern(s) will assist the Outdoor Program Director with program administration and leading youth camp, including:
  - a. Serve as a Team and Activity Leader at summer camp:
    - i. Ensure the safety of each camper.
    - ii. Be playful and bring the magic of camp.
    - iii. Lead activities for youth ages 9-17.
    - iv. Engage with campers and provide encouragement and mentoring.
    - v. Provide discipline when needed for the good order of the team.
  - b. Camp Administration
    - vi. Assist with general administrative tasks and planning.
    - vii. Assist with marketing of summer camp on social media.
    - viii. Manage Camper Registration and the Scholarship Program.
    - ix. Assist with website development and on-line events.
  - c. Community Event Coordination, including:
    - x. Planning, coordination, and marketing of fundraising events such as bake sales and car washes.
    - xi. Planning and coordination of camper participation at Battle Ground parade and booth, and Hockinson Fun Days booth.
- 2. The Summer Camp Intern(s) will also assist with rental reservations, cleaning, and hospitality:
  - a. Assist with facility rentals:
    - xii. Reservation confirmation and scheduling.
    - xiii. Confirm User Agreements, deposits, insurance coverage and final payments.
    - xiv. Managing records and communications with facility renters.
  - b. Provide Hospitality to Camp Renters
    - xv. Inspect facilities before check-out and ensure the facilities are cleaned by renters.
    - xvi. Clean as needed and restock bathroom supplies for all guests.
    - xvii. Manage dumpster and recycling loads and order extra pick-ups as needed.
    - xviii. Inspect lighting, smoke detectors and fire extinguishers.
    - xix. Move tables, chairs, and benches to accommodate guests and camp programs.
    - xx. Assist with maintenance of 15 acres of lawn and 2 miles of trails.
